Purposes and Specifications of Replacing Outdated Computers in Room 411

Purposes

The computers in Room 411 were installed 11 years ago. The specifications (Pentium CPU, 2G RAM) are far outdated to meet the current requirements of many software and Operation System in different aspects such as online learning, video editing, graphic design, etc. In the past two years, online learning has become a “must” for students. Our 11-year-old machines can hardly perform even some basic functions of online learning software and it greatly affects the learning and teaching effectiveness. Although some needy students have requested to stay in school for online learning because of COVID-19, we have no ways to accommodate them due to the deficiency of the machines. Other than this, many after school activities or life-wide learning activities such as STEM activities (3D design, IoT etc) and competitions that need a lot of video editing require higher computer configurations. With the present settings, the students’ learning of these activities has become ineffective or even impossible. It is believed that either online learning or learning in STEM becomes a trend and “new normal” in nowadays schooling and therefore there is an urgent need to carry out the project.
